***Call for Entries: Logo Designing***

The Delhi Commission for Protection of Child Rights (DCPCR) has been constituted under the Commission for Protection of Child Rights (CPCR) Act, 2005. It is the statutory watchdog of the Government of Delhi on matters of child rights.

DCPCR invites entries for designing the logo for the *Children First Journal on Children's Lives* to represent the Journal on the global platform.

**Brief on Children First Journal**

*Children First Journal on Children's Lives* is a bi-annual and peer-reviewed journal launched by the DCPCR). It was launched with the aim of deepening and broadening the discourse on child rights by providing a platform to all persons who are engaged with the rights of children in varied capacities to share their learnings, views and experiences

It is an inclusive, multidisciplinary publication to engage in discussions, discourse, sharing of good practices and publish original academic research, good practices, voices from the ground, reflections, commentaries, critiques, policy analysis, and book reviews.

With the Journal, DCPCR aims to build an inclusive, multidisciplinary space for engagement for people regardless of their backgrounds and hence, has opened its



submissions to academicians, practitioners, grassroots workers, activists, and others who engage with the field of child rights.

### **General Guidelines:**

1. The opportunity is open to all individuals across all age groups, disciplines etc.
2. Multiple entries by the same participant will be considered, only if submitted separately.
3. A short description should be provided to explain the concept of the logo designed and its' alignment with the journal.
4. The participant must be the same person who has designed the logo and plagiarism would not be allowed.
5. You are to submit the design only via google form at:

6. The last date for submission of entries is **21-10-2022 upto 6 PM.**
7. The selected logo shall be recognised accordingly.
8. The logo must not contain provocative, objectionable or inappropriate content.

### **Design/Technical Guidelines:**

1. Minimum Size of the Logo shall be 4" X 4" (4 inches X 4 inches).
2. Participants should not imprint or watermark logo design.
3. Logo can be both hand-designed and designed on a digital platform. In the case of hand-designed, a high-quality image should be submitted in JPG, PNG and PDF formats.
4. If the logo is designed digitally, it should be submitted in JPG, PNG and PDF formats only. The image of the logo should be at least 500 dpi.
5. If the logo is shortlisted, the participant may be required to submit the design in an editable and open file format.
6. The participants will be required to submit an undertaking of the originality of design and transfer of copyright to DCPCR.

7. The selection would be on the basis of the message, elements of creativity, originality, artistic merit, technical excellence, visual impact and theme of the design.

8. Logo shall not include any material (Photograph, icon, symbol etc) that is copyright protected. Anyone found infringing on others' copyright would be disqualified. The Commission does not bear any responsibility for copyright violations or infringements of intellectual property carried out by the participants.
